Blueberries grow on bushes. Each blueberry is small and round. Many blueberries can grow on one bush. When they first appear, the blueberries are green.

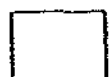
The green berries are not ready to be eaten. They need a lot of sunlight and water to help them become fat and sweet. When the berries turn blue, they are ripe and ready to be picked.

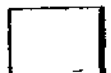
