If one wants proof that aromatherapy does indeed solve all the problems it claims to, one will not find it. Scientists draw a line between aromatherapy and *aromachology a new name for the scientific study of odours effects on mood emotion and behaviour*.

From studies and research, scientists have confirmed some of its claims. One of these is that *lavender is truly relaxing and can help to boost one's mood, improving the quality of sleep. Lemon-balm oil when dabbed on the faces and arms of elderly patients with dementia can have a calming effect. Rosemary does really perk one up and reduce anxiety.*

Aromatherapy safe and worth trying?

So is *aromatherapy safe and worth trying?* If the aromatherapist is well-trained and the therapy is conducted in the correct manner, one does not have anything to worry about. If *improperly they can cause burns headaches and nausea.* the oils are used *improperly, they can cause burns, allergic reactions, headaches and nausea.* The bottom line is, if it works for you, it works.

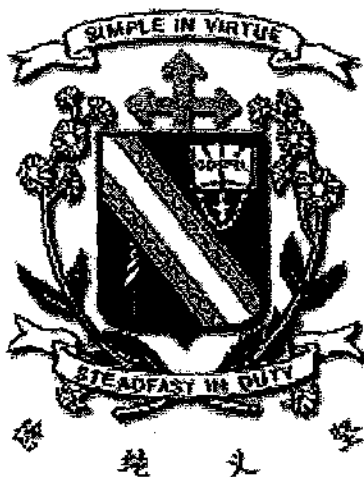

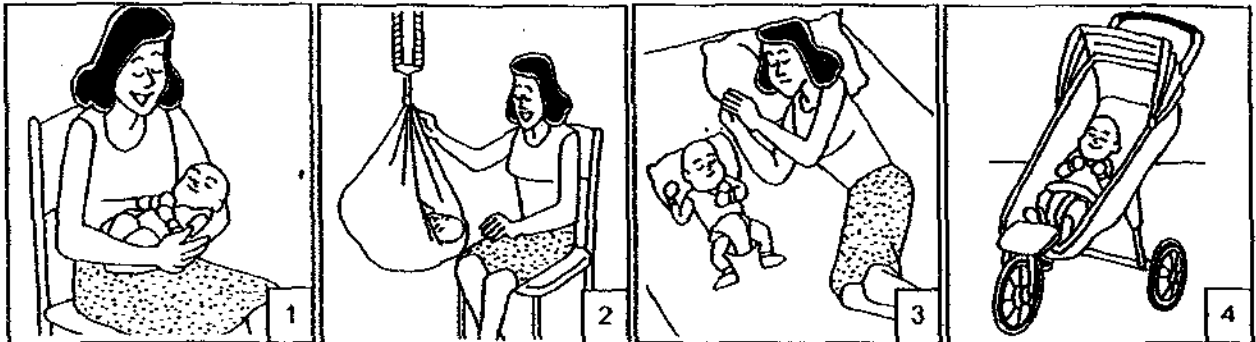

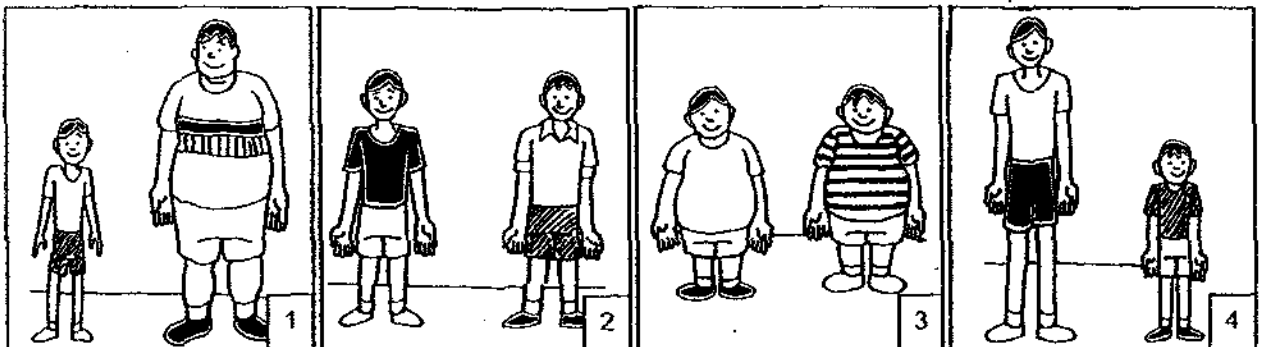
