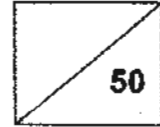

POLAR BEARS

Characteristics

Polar bears spend much of their lives around water. They are excellent swimmers and have an average lifespan of around 30 years.

The polar bear's yellowish white appearance is caused by a reflection of light. Its fur has no white pigment at all but is translucent and hollow. Under its fur, the polar bear's skin is entirely black. They have a dense coat and a layer of fat to enable them to adapt to harsh temperatures.

Habitat

Polar bears are found in the Arctic regions. They are always on the sea ice as it provides a platform from which they can breed and hunt easily. They dig big dens to shield themselves from extreme weather conditions.

Diet

In winter, polar bears typically need a daily intake of about two kg of fat. Their prey includes seals, walruses, beached whales, fish, seabirds and their hatchings and even other polar bears. In summer, they eat berries, roots and kelp.

Breeding

Mating takes place around April and May. The female bears will go into deep dens for about four months. One to three cubs are born each time. The mothers will care for them and teach them to hunt for two years before they leave the cubs to go their separate ways.

Survival

Research has shown that more than a quarter of polar bear populations are in decline. Climate change is their biggest threat. They are specialised for a life on sea ice, which leaves them vulnerable to changes in their habitat.

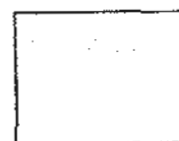

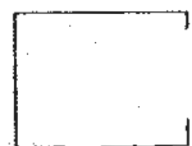

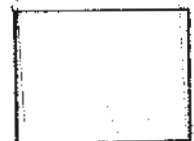
